

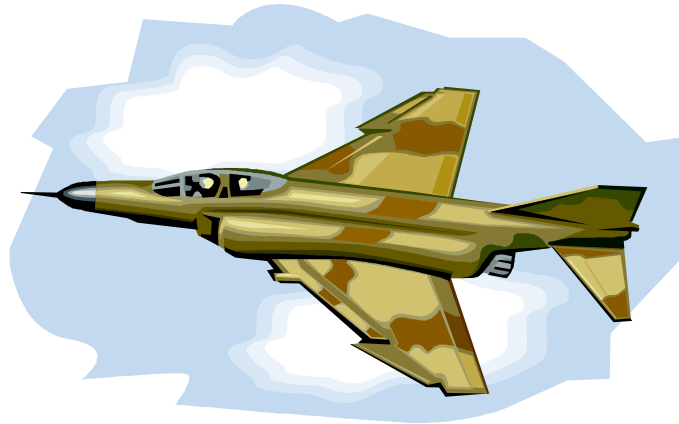
## Museum of Aviation – Warner Robins, GA
