

THE MUSEUM OF AVIATION

AT WARNER ROBINS TOUR!



The **Museum of Aviation** at Warner Robins, GA is the second-largest aerospace museum of the United States Air Force. The Museum has a total of five different buildings which house 93 military aircraft on 51 acres. The SR-71A Blackbird on display (pictured above) is the current record holder for flight airspeed. Serial number 61-7958 set an absolute speed record of 1,905.81 knots (2,193.2 mph; 3,529.6 km/h) on July 28, 1976, which stands today.

Most aircraft are displayed in period correct settings which can make you feel like you are there, being a part of history yourself. All eras of aircraft are represented from WWII, the Korean War, Vietnam, the Cold War to the present day. The full spectrum of Air Force aircraft including fighters, bombers, attack, cargo, reconnaissance, utility plus various missiles can be viewed up close and personal. If you are a fan of military aviation, it doesn't get much better than this!
